- Be knowledgeable of and follow School policies and procedures as described in the Employee Handbook
- Assist in preparing the learning environment, setting up activity centers and preparing needed material and supplies in advance as instructed by the teacher. Class preparation is done at a time when the Employee in not responsible for supervising the students.

Physical Demands / Work Environment

- Work is primarily performed in the school environment. The school is dynamic with a high level of activity. Work may also be performed at other sites for field trips.
- Must be able to lift 40 pounds.

- Depending upon activities and season, may be required to be outdoors for regular, prolonged activities.
