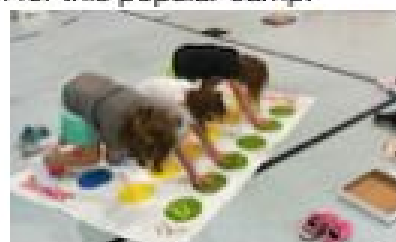
### June 10 - 14 Outdoor Adventures
