

Dear Parents and Guardians,

This letter contains information that you will help you and your child prepare for a successful experience at Camp Country Day.

Camp hours are from 9:00 AM – 3:00 PM. Extended care is provided from 7:30 – 8:45 AM and 3:00-5:30 PM, and must be prepaid. Information will be provided as soon as it is finalized. Campers who arrive at 8:45 or later or are picked up by 3:15 will not be billed for extended care. The day will be packed with activities, so campers are not to bring electronic devices.

Lunch prepared by Chef Frank Esposito is included, but a drink is not provided. We suggest that your child bring a refillable water bottle each day for lunch and to help them remain hydrated, as we do many outdoor activities.

All campers should be dressed in comfortable play clothes and shoes that are appropriate for the day's activities. Closed toe shoes are required for going in the woods, and shoes must have a heel strap in order for campers to go on the playground structure. There will be many outdoor activities so please apply sunscreen before sending your child to camp.

Each Wednesday will be Wacky Wednesday! Campers will play on the slip and slide in the morning, and then hike to the adjacent park to have a picnic lunch, play on the playground, and explore the creek. Campers should bring a bathing suit and towel for the morning, and clothes and shoes that can get wet and dirty for the afternoon. The day may change based on the weather forecast or other special events, but we will do our best to have these activities each week. If there is a change, we will let you know as far in advance as possible.

All non-CCDS campers must have a Camp Country Day 2019 Emergency Medical Information and Authorization form on file for summer camps. Parents of current CCDS students will be asked to verify information but will not need to fill out a new form. You only need one form for the entire summer for each child, however each child must have their own form on file. The weekly trip to the park is considered a field trip, so all parents will also be required to fill out a Field Trip Permission form. Campers who are unable to attend scheduled field trips will have to be picked up from camp before field trip departure times.
